3. Matters Arising

Queen's Platinum Jubilee

Thanks were extended to everyone who supported the events planned for Sunday June 5th. There were a good range of stalls, Brass Band and games at the recreation ground plus the unveiling of the Jubilee Stone. This was followed by a street party along Church Terrace.

PROW

The footpath Farnley Bank is progressing towards being referred to committee at Kirklees.

IVY Farm

The unauthorised track on Thurstonland Road is in the process of being investigated by Kirklees Enforcement (COMP/21/0460).

Post Office Van

The Post Office Van is still visiting the village once a week and continues to park on Church Terrace for the duration of its stay.

4. Financial Statement

Balance as July 6th 2022 is £2,993.14

The above Balance includes £1,152 flutter membership and the £300 annual grant from Kirkburton Parish Council. An email has been sent to KPC thanking them for their continued support of the FT CG.

Jubilee event costs, income and expenditure are as follows;

Income

Jubilee Grant and monies from event stallholders plus sale of excess drinks to the Bowling Club £555

Expenses

Banners and Flyers, Slaithwaite Brass Band, hire of Portaloos £576.72

So far this leaves a shortfall of £21.27 paid for by the FT CG funds.

Movements since the FT CG meeting in June were;

Payments in £255, Jubilee event.

Total payments in= £255.

Payments out, £264, expenses for Jubilee event. £50, Flutter winner June 2022. £140, Fee for Saithwaite Brass Band. £5.40, HSBC monthly fee of £5 plus charges due to cheque transactions.

Total Payments out=£459.40

The current balance now includes;

£220 operating costs from the £1000 COVID grants received from Kirkburton Parish Council

£350 for future flutter winners

£300 annual grant received from Kirkburton Parish Council.

Total to hold is approximately £1770.

This leaves around £1000 than can be put towards something to benefit the community.

This will be an agenda item on the FT CG meeting in September.

NB, a resident has already suggested that some form of additional play equipment at the recreation ground but any other ideas which can put before the September meeting are welcomed as well.

5.Council Updates

Kirklees Council

Notification of TTRO (Temporary Traffic Restriction Order). A reminder that Moor Lane will be closed from 25th July 2022- 28th July 2022 for carriage resurfacing.

Cllr Armer agreed, on behalf of the FTCCG to thank the appropriate department in Kirklees that removes fly tipping around the village. A rather large amount opposite the top of Storthes Hall lane has recently been removed and Kirklees are prompt in removing fly tipping when it is reported, especially if notified online via the Kirklees website.

Kirkburton Parish Council

Congratulations were extended to Cllr Barraclough who has been elected as Vice-Chair of Kirkburton Parish Council.

6.St Lucius Church

St Lucius Church has achieved a silver award in recognition of their vision for making St Lucius an Eco Church. This is an incredible achievement in less than a year and thanks must go to everyone involved.

Volunteers are sought for another tidy up session on Saturday 6th July 10.30am-12.30. Bacon/tomato butties and tea/coffee provided for all volunteers.

St Lucius Church are holding an outdoor service in the churchyard on Sunday 17th July at 11am. There will be activities for children and adults. Following the service there will be a bring and share picnic in the churchyard (weather permitting). Tea, coffee and juice will be provided.
