

WY Metro AccessBus, available in Farnley Tyas

AccessBus is a dial-a-ride bus service providing door-to-door local transport, seven days a week between 9am and 5pm.

It is of particular benefit to people who are unable to use standard bus services, as the driver assists passengers from door-to-door, including boarding and alighting. The buses are fully accessible, fitted with seatbelts and the most up-to-date wheelchair restraints.

A recent initiative from Stocksmoor by Liz Turner has established a WY Metro Access bus route from Stocksmoor to Morrisons at Waterloo.

This service now comes through Farnley Tyas and could pick up eligible residents

Details are

Wednesday approx 10.15am returning approx 12.15 Morrisons Waterloo.

They pick up at your address take you to Morrisons door.

You are told a time to return (most go in cafe and wait).

Picked up at Morrisons door.

Return to your home and thus far the driver has carried their bags.

You need to have a bus pass or disability pass live in Kirklees to use the service.

Wheelchair users can also use .

There is a form to fill in with name date of birth, etc, and if you will be taking mobility aid ie walker etc.

It's really good, drivers are super helpful and absolutely no lifting or carrying of bags to do. I can either register people or give them details to do themselves.
